Water Miser's wear tolerance is ideal for home lawns, parks and athletic fields.

Water Miser is especially dark green and will establish a very deep root structure for extended periods of heat and drought. *Water Miser* requires less frequent irrigation than perennial ryegrass, fine fescue and Kentucky bluegrass. *Water Miser* features a finer leaf texture than most other tall fescue varieties and has improved resistance to turf diseases such as Brown Patch.





Growth characteristics:

- Deep rooted
- Deep, dark green color
- Medium-fine leaf texture
- Dense, upright growth habit

Establishment and maintenance:

- Seeding rate:
7-10 lbs./1,000 sq. ft. in early fall or spring
- Apply starter fertilizer 7-10 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
- Keep seedbed moist during germination/
establishment
- First mowing should occur when turf reaches
2-3 inches in height. Do not mow more
than one-third of plant height

Performance characteristics:

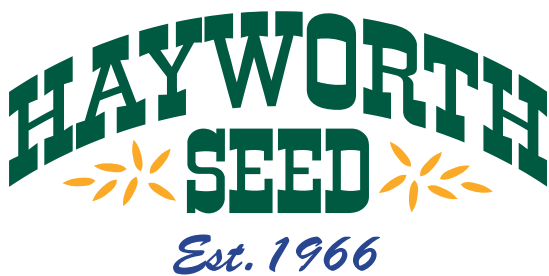
- Good Brown Patch disease resistance
- Excellent heat and drought tolerance
- High endophyte content for insect
resistance
- Good sun and shade performance

Seasonal maintenance:

- Fertilize at 4-5 lbs. of Nitrogen
per sq. ft./year
- Irrigate deeply and infrequently during
periods of high temperature and
absence of rainfall
- Mow and maintain turf at 1.5 to 3 inches
- For heavier shaded areas, a higher
height of cut (3 inches, plus)
is recommended
